Many people do not realize that the Covid pandemic increased addictions in the United States over 30%. Drug overdose deaths also increased by over 30%, too. All these lives matter to us here at Trinity, as well as, to the Lord Jesus Christ! He doesn't want anyone to perish without Him.

The Surprise: The County Commissioners of Montgomery County are in the final stages of donating the residence known as the "Trinity House" and acreage that it sits on to Trinity. 
